
FANTASTIC CENTRAL LOCATION



Since 2000, the Bendigo Relay for Life has raised \$3.6 million for cancer research and support services. According to the Cancer Council, over 750 people are diagnosed with cancer in Greater Bendigo each year

Organised by passionate, local volunteers, each Relay event is an experience that will stay with you forever. Activities are designed to celebrate Survivors and recognise their Carers. Everyone then meets at the Relay to celebrate in a relay-style walk, while being entertained by local performers and activities.

Faye, pictured here started to get involved in Relay For Life in 2000 after a dear girlfriend died in 1996 at the age of 40 after fighting cancer on and off for 10 years. She was an inspiration through her many battles.

"We started a village team in the relay in 2015. It always amazes me how many walkers we get.

Despite the hard work, I think it is a highlight of the village and a great time with fellow villagers. Over the 8 years we have raised \$83,022. In 2018 we raised the most funds at the Relay in Bendigo since it started 19 years ago with \$17,026. This amount was also helped with Bill Johnson's Kakoda walk.



Our main fundraisers are the Trivia nights and collection of 5 and 10 cent coins. Now any coins. We have held 20 Trivia nights raising \$31,020. We started with 54 at our first event and 24 of the originals are still coming. Our highest attendance is 102.

Our coins have raised \$3,141 and many from the village give cash donations. There is such a great support for the relay as so many of us unfortunately, have or are being affected by this terrible disease. Hopefully with our help we are getting somewhere. I'm sure every little bit gets us closer to a cure. "said Faye

"When Bellarine Lakes Country Club managers Mark and Tanya Prebble introduced our own television channels, content was needed. General discussion then included how the residents could be involved in producing programs. The laughter and music is a key part of this active water aerobics group. A great work out and a lot of fun had by all involved.








AN ACTIVE PET FRIENDLY COMMUNITY
